NOTIFICATION

In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Rajasthan hereby makes the following rules further to amend the Rajasthan Technical Education Subordinate Service Rules, 1973, namely:-

1. Short title and commencement.- (1) These rules may be called the Rajasthan Technical Education Subordinate Service (Amendment) Rules, 2021.

(2) They shall come into force from the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. Amendment of rule 2.- After the existing clause (a) and before the existing clause (b) of rule 2 of the Rajasthan Technical Education Subordinate Service Rules, 1973, hereinafter referred to as the said rules, the following new clause (aa) shall be inserted, namely:-

“(aa) “Board” means the Rajasthan Staff Selection Board;”

3. Amendment of rule 4.- In sub-rule (1) of rule 4 of the said rules, for the existing expression "schedule", the expression "Schedule-I" shall be substituted.

4. Amendment of rule 5.- In clause (a) of rule 5 of the said rules, for the existing expression “schedule”, the expression “Schedule-I” shall be substituted.

5. Amendment of rule 6.- In rule 6 of the said rules,-

i) for the existing expression "Schedule", wherever occurring, the expression "Schedule-I" shall be substituted; and

ii) for the existing expression "Commission, where necessary", the expression "Board" shall be substituted.

6. Amendment of rule 7.- In sub-rule (3) of rule 7 of the said rules, for the existing expression “by the Commission, for posts falling in its purview, and by the Appointing Authority in other cases,”, the expression “by the Board/Appointing Authority, as the case may be” shall be substituted.

7. Amendment of rule 9.- In rule 9 of the said rules, for the existing expression "in the Schedule must", the expression "in the Schedule-I must" shall be substituted.

8. Amendment of rule 10.- In rule 10 of the said rules, for the existing expression "Schedule", wherever occurring, the expression "Schedule-I" shall be substituted.

9. Amendment of rule 13.- In rule 13 of the said rules,-

i) for the existing expression “Commission”, wherever occurring, the expression “Board” shall be substituted;

- ii) for the existing expression "interview", wherever occurring, the expression "written examination" shall be substituted; and
- iii) the existing clause (a) shall be substituted by the following, namely :-
“(a) by the Board or the Appointing Authority, as the case may be, from admission to any examination, and”

10. Amendment of rule 15.- In sub-rule (2) of rule 15 of the said rules, for the existing expression "Schedule", the expression "Schedule-I" shall be substituted.

11. Amendment of rule 16.- In rule 16 of the said rules, for the existing expression "Commission", the expression "Board" shall be substituted.

12. Amendment of rule 17.- In rule 17 of the said rules, for the existing expression "Commission", wherever occurring, the expression "Board" shall be substituted.

13. Amendment of rule 18.- In rule 18 of the said rules, for the existing expression "Commission", wherever occurring, the expression "Board" shall be substituted.

14. Amendment of rule 19.- In rule 19 of the said rules,-

- (i) for the existing expression "Commission", wherever occurring, the expression "Board" shall be substituted; and
- (ii) for the existing expression " before it for interview", the expression "in written examination conducted by it" shall be substituted.

15. Insertion of new rule 19A and 19B.- After rule 19, so amended and before the existing rule 20 of the said rules, the following new rule 19A and 19B shall be inserted, namely:-

“19A. Scheme and syllabus for the post of Draftsman/Technician/Laboratory Assistant.- The post of Draftsman /Technician / Laboratory Assistant shall be filled in by written examination conducted by the Board in accordance with the Scheme and Syllabus of the examination as prescribed in Schedule-II

19B. Admission to the examination.- (1) The applications which are found to be incomplete and have not been filled in accordance with the instructions issued by the Board/Appointing Authority, as the case may be, shall be rejected by the Board/ Appointing Authority, as the case may be, at the initial stage. The Board/Appointing Authority, as the case may be, shall permit the rest of those candidates to appear in the examination provisionally to whom they consider it proper to grant the certificate of admission. No candidate shall be admitted to an examination unless he/she holds a certificate of admission to that examination, granted by the Board/Appointing Authority, as the case may be. Before appearing at the examination, it should be ensured by the candidate himself/herself that he/she fulfils the conditions in regard to age, educational qualifications, experience etc., as provided in these rules. Being allowed to take the examination shall not entitle the candidate to presumption of eligibility.

(2) The decision of the Board/Appointing Authority, as the case may be, as to the admission of a candidate in the examination, eligibility shall be final.”

16. Amendment of rule 20.- In rule 20 of the said rules, for the existing expression "Commission", wherever occurring, the expression "Board" shall be substituted.

17. Substitution of Schedule.- The existing Schedule appended to the said rules shall be substituted by the following, namely:-

18. Addition of new Schedule-II.- After Schedule-I, so substituted, the following new Schedule-II shall be added, namely:-

**Scheme and Syllabus of written examination for the post of Draftsman/Technician/
Laboratory Assistant**

1. The question paper of written examination shall carry multiple choices type questions.
2. Duration of examination shall be three hours.

3. All questions shall carry equal marks and there shall be no negative marking.

Syllabus of examination :


(1) Syllabus for the post of Draftsman/ Technician shall be in accordance with the syllabus of certificate course of the NCVT in appropriate trades, as amended from time to time.

(2) Syllabus for the post of Laboratory Assistant shall be in accordance with the syllabus of Physics and Chemistry of Senior Secondary standard.

Scheme of examination: The question paper should include the following sections which shall carry the number of questions and the number of marks, as in following manner:-
